 - A. Capital Engineering in cooperation with CPRD is proceeding with a pedestrian crossing of Fernwood near Brutscher.
- iii. Keller Associates, Inc. Engineering Study - N Brutscher Street adjacent to the Fairfield Inn at 900 N Brutscher Street.
 - A. After reviewing an initial engineering study of pedestrian crossings along N Brutscher Street adjacent to the Fairfield Inn, the City Manager has not directed Keller to continue with this study.
