Answer: *Inside Out and Back Again* by Thanhhà Lại (p. 89)

**4. In which book does a character have an artificial leg?**

Answer: *Just Like Click* by Sandy Grubb (p. 44)

**5. In which book does a character build a plywood mountain range?**

Answer: *Better with Butter* by Victoria Piontek (p. 241)

**6. In which book is the setting Hickory Valley?**

Answer: Highwater. (p. 33)

**15. In *The Secret Garden on 81<sup>st</sup> Street*, what type of flower is Colin’s favorite?**

Answer: Roses. (p. 146)

Answer: He is sprayed by a skunk. (p. 125)
