Recommendation:

A potential motion could be formatted like this: "I move that the draft council goals list be moved to the next city council session to form the basis of a resolution."

Executive Summary:

It has been just over two years since the council has reviewed and updated its council goals and staff have received a request from the honorable mayor to re-initiate the process once again.

The CM proposed via email to follow a similar methodology to that used last time.

The agreed process has the following steps:

- 1. This is occurring as part of an official work session, using the new Owl meeting device with minutes and recording.
- 2. Councilors will email me with suggestions for new council goals ahead of the meeting.
- 3. Goals that are extremely similar (with just wording differences) will be blended together.
- 4. The list will be deliberated in the session to see if any gain no traction.
- 5. In the session we will review the old and new goals and objectives.
- 6. The deliberations will lead to a motion that would move the finished list back to the next regular council session for adoption.

This meeting comprises step 1, and steps 2 and 3 have already occurred prior to January 25th 2025.

After deliberations are complete today, council will complete steps 4 through 6 ending with a motion to send the package back to a regular council session for public review and possible further debate.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no way to easily assess the fiscal impact of our new council goals. With that said periodically taking stock of the city's objectives is a fiscally prudent thing to do.

Council Goals:
