City of Newberg Boards Committees, and Commissions

Affordable Housing Commission – Provides recommendations on how to best spend money out of the Newberg Affordable Housing Trust Fund (NAHFT).

Budget Committee – Publicly reviews the proposed budget to provide opportunity for public-input.

Rate Review Committee – Considers the rates for the City's wastewater and water systems. Also, the amount of the stormwater maintenance fee, and other fees and rates.

Historic Preservation Commission – Identifies, recognizes, and preserves significant property that hold community history.

Library Advisory Board – Generates policy for the library and provides input on library operations.

Planning Commission – Helps make big decisions on land use matters in our community.

Traffic Safety Commission – Provides a venue for the residents of Newberg to voice traffic safety concerns, evaluate related issues, provide a liaison with the City and promote traffic safety within the community.
