



Dear Residents and Business Owners,

The City of Newberg Water Department will be conducting operational testing of the water distribution system in your area in preparation for upcoming valve replacements at the intersection of Edwards Street and 1st Street.

This testing is scheduled for **Tuesday, March 24, 2026, between approximately 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.**

During this time, City maintenance staff will be verifying their ability to isolate sections of the water system. As a result, customers in the surrounding area **may experience water pressure fluctuations and occasional brief service interruptions** while crews test and operate system valves.

These interruptions, if they occur, are expected to be short in duration. This testing is necessary to ensure crews can safely isolate line segments when the valve replacement work is performed.

We recommend that customers plan accordingly and limit water use if pressure drops occur during the testing period.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we do this important work to maintain and improve the reliability of Newberg's water system.
